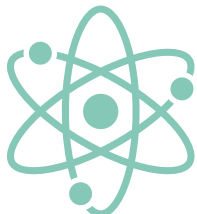

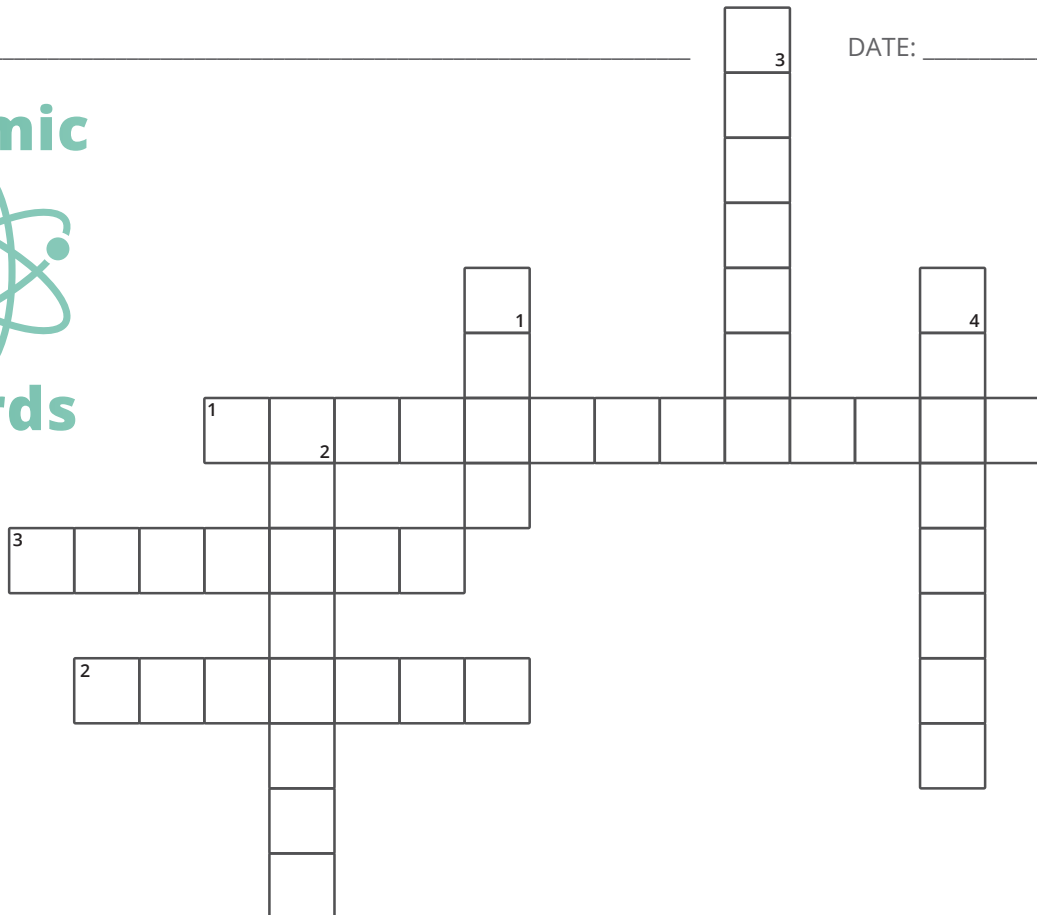

1. An arrangement of chemical elements in order of atomic number that groups elements with common characteristics in the same area of the table
2. A particle that has a mass nearly equal to that of the proton but no electrical charge and that is present in all atomic nuclei except those of hydrogen
3. The central part of an atom that includes nearly all of the atomic mass and consists of protons and usually neutrons

Down:

1. The smallest particle of an element that has the properties of the element and can exist either alone or in combination
2. An elementary particle that has a negative charge of electricity and travels around the nucleus of an atom
3. Any of more than 100 fundamental substances that consist of atoms of only one kind and that cannot be separated by ordinary chemical means into simpler substances
4. The smallest particle of a substance having all the characteristics of the substance and is composed of one or more atoms
